- 2. **Photograph Copy:** Show a digital image of your negative test result or your vaccination card. Please make sure your test result displays a date/time stamp.

WHAT ADDITIONAL SAFETY MEASURES ARE IN PLACE?

- All vendors are encouraged to use Cashless Transactions
- Protective gloves are recommended when handling cash transactions
- Additional hand washing stations will be added, where applicable
- Hand sanitizer will be strategically located throughout location, where applicable
- TBBHF strongly encourages all attendees to wear face covering when not social distancing or in a line
